Dear Parents / Carers,

School Meals

The price of school dinners is now £2.10 per day, so a week will now cost £10.50. The price of an adult meal has increased to £2.88.

The cost of school meals for the first half term is - £79.80.

School meals must be paid for in advance, you may either pay weekly, monthly or for the whole half term.

Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 pupils are still receiving universal free school meals so there is no need to pay.

Payment of money

It is an audit requirement that we are unable to accept loose money or cheques. Money must be sent in a clearly labelled envelope, including your child's name, class and what the money is for. We are no longer able to accept loose money. Thank you for your support with this.

First Aid

The majority of staff across the Federation spent the first two days of term completing a Paediatric First Course together. As well as providing valuable training for our staff this was also a good opportunity for staff to continue to get to know each other.

You are probably aware that we have altered the forms we complete following an injury. Parents are now asked to sign the form (which we than keep for our records). Thank you for your support with this change to our practice.
