A child's meal is - £2.20, so a week costs £11.00.

The cost of school meals for the second half term is - £77.00.

School meals must be paid for in advance, you may either pay weekly, monthly or for the whole half term. **Due to the current situation we must insist that payment is sent in a clearly labelled envelope, thank you.** We are unable to accept money that is not in an envelope.

Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 pupils continue to receive universal free school meals so there is no need to pay.
