<p>9.15 - 9.35 Spelling</p>	<p>Please ask an adult to read your spellings out loud in order to carry out your test. Don't forget to let me know how you did.</p> <p>Spelling focus for next week:</p> <p>Years 3 and 4: the ending spelt "-ture"</p> <p>Years 5 and 6: adding the suffix -fer (the -fer part is stressed, so the r is doubled.)</p> <p><i>How will you practise your spellings this week?</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- You could use the LOOK - COVER - WRITE - CHECK method <u>OR</u>

	Try writing your spellings out 3x every day to build up fluency and practise your handwriting.
