Please read the newsletter carefully and make a note of any important dates which are coming up next term, both schools have a packed last term of the year!


<u>Dinner Money</u> – The price for a child's meal is - £2.10, so a week will cost £10.50. The price of an adult meal is £2.88. The cost of meals for Summer 5 is £39.90. Please make cheques payable to Derbyshire County Council or DCC. Next term (Summer 6) the cost for meals is £71.40.

School meals must be paid for in advance, you may either pay weekly, monthly or for the whole half term. Payment must be sent in a clearly labelled envelope, thank you.

Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 pupils are still receiving universal free school meals so there is no need to pay.
