Contact tracing over the Easter holidays

Once again, during the half term holiday, schools will be playing an important role in contact tracing and the national effort to limit the spread of coronavirus (COVID-19). This is a key part of the test and trace process, as schools hold the data about close contacts and pupil contact details.

During the half term holiday staff, students, parents and carers only need to inform the school of a positive case where they have developed symptoms within 48 hours of being in school. I will check my emails daily between 9am and 10:30am. Please email (t.bosley@acornfed.derbyshire.sch.uk) if your child develops symptoms and you are going for a test. Then let me know the result of the test as soon as you can. Please include in a contact number in your email.

Where pupils or staff test positive for coronavirus (COVID-19) during the holidays, having developed symptoms more than 48 hours since being in an education setting, we are not required to take any action. If this is the case, please follow contact tracing instructions provided by NHS Test and Trace.

Contact with a positive case during the holiday

Where pupils or students need to self-isolate due to contact with a positive case during the holidays, we do not need to be informed about this until the 7th June when we return to school.



School Uniform and PE Kit

We understand that at the present time it can be more difficult than usual to buy the correct uniform for the children to wear and at the moment we are turning a 'blind eye' to children who are not in the correct uniform as long as the clothes they are wearing are suitable.
