Art and Design:

Have a go at making your own juggling balls but sewing two pieces of material together and stuffing them!

History:

English:

Find some interesting facts about the circus and create an information poster to share with your friends at school. Some things to consider could be: when the first circus was opened, the different acts you can see at a circus and which animals are used in performances.

Free Choice:

As we come to the end of our school year, you can choose to create your own homework project to represent your year at school. Think about the things you have enjoyed at school, the friendships you have made and all of your achievements.

Some ways that you could present this project are: as a mood board/collage, as a story or a poem, or in a picture/painting.
