Design and Technology:

Build your own igloo.

Create a set of

instructions on how to

make your igloo,

including a list of

resources needed!

History:

Research Ernest Shackleton, a famous explorer. Why is he famous? Was there anybody else like him? Record some of your findings with pictures, if possible.

Art:

Use a range of media to create an arctic scene. What colours would you use to create your scene? What animals might be in your picture?

Geography:

Research Inuit people and how they live. How are their lives different to ours? Are there any similarities between their lives and ours? Record some of your findings.

Maths:

We have learned that penguins can grow to the height of a six year old! Can you find how big other arctic animals can grow? What are they the same size as? Order your animals from smallest to largest.

PSHE:

Create a poster to teach people how to stay safe in cold conditions. Consider the dark mornings and nights, choice of clothing, road safety etc.
